The research, published in the Feb. 20, 2013, online edition of the journal Nature, could lead to new ways to prevent cancer from spreading. “The ability of cancer cells to invade the basement membrane, which surrounds epithelial tissue, is a critical step in the process of metastasis,” says Ann Peterson, assistant professor of pathology at the University of Chicago and one of the study’s lead authors. “This is the first time that an effect of glyphosate, the active ingredient in Roundup, has been shown to enhance invasion of cancer cells.” Peterson says that the finding sheds new light on the “awful truth” that glyphosate, the herbicide used in approximately 70 percent of U.S. crops, is carcinogenic. The study, Peterson says, “adds another piece to the puzzle about the relationship between glyphosate and cancer.” Human exposure to glyphosate has been linked to a broad spectrum of diseases including kidney disease and cancer. This is the first study to suggest that glyphosate, when used in the right concentrations and on the right crops, can also promote the spread of cancer cells. Peterson’s team included scientists from the University of Chicago and the University of California, San Diego, as well as international collaborators including France’s Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique and China’s Shanghai Jiao Tong University. After studying the effect of glyphosate on cancer cells in the laboratory, Peterson’s team wanted to see if they could replicate their in vitro findings with patients’ cancer cells in the body. Peterson’s team tested the invasiveness and metastatic potential of colon cancer cells from biopsies of two groups of people: patients who had been exposed f678ea9f9e
